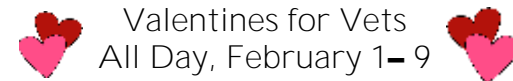

 Representatives from Great Lakes Caring Home Health & Hospice will discuss options available to families and patients if the need for hospice or long-term care arises. No registration is required.

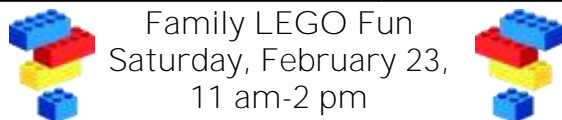
**Tech Club**
